Goals for 2012-2013

The major goal for Shared Governance identified in the Pioneer Plan for Progress was to review the efficacy of the Parent-School subcommittee.

Another agenda item added after the beginning of the school year was to review a definition of diversity provided by the Diversity subcommittee for possible inclusion in the Diversity Essential School Structures document.

Progress with Respect to Goal:

1. Upon Shared Governance recommendation: The Parent –School Subcommittee was deactivated as an active subcommittee. Rationale included the fact that the subcommittee had not met for three years due to a lack of an agenda, and that much of the identified purposes of the subcommittee are met by other subcommittees.
2. Shared Governance reviewed the proposed definition of diversity submitted by the Diversity Committee. Revisions were suggested and returned to Diversity. A revised document was sent to Shared Governance in early May. Review of this revised definition will be an agenda item for 2013-2014.

Goals for 2013-2014

Review the second draft of the definition of Diversity for possible inclusion in the Essential School Structures document

Review the selection process of the Admissions Committee to see if specified term limits are warranted.
