Meeting called to order by Liz Kinsella on February 11, 2026, at 6:30.

Officer Reports

President <i>Liz Kinsella</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Regarding the calendar for next year, school will start Aug. 14. The last day of school is yet to be determined. with various end dates being discussed.• There will be no meeting next month.• We are looking for people to fill openings on the Boosters team specifically a new Secretary and a head (or 2 heads) of Spiritwear.
VP <i>Erin Easter</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Still working on fundraising options for Fine Arts. The biggest motivation for having a separate entity for fundraising would be so Fine Arts can apply for grants. Erin envisions this to be separate from Boosters. They need to obtain non-profit status. Boosters does already have non-profit status, but there are concerns about surpassing too high of an income level.• Also related to fundraising, would like to make instructions to donate to U-High through the ISU Foundation more accessible.• At the next meeting, would like to discuss a plan for fundraising in the future. Possibility of a suggested onetime donation that families could consider making per student to cover things like After Prom and smaller grant requests. This could possibly eliminate Gold Rush.

Administration Report (*Andrea Markert – Principal*)

- Recently there were parent meetings with the Dean and Provost about misinformation surrounding funding for the Lab schools. U-High has assurance that we will receive a portion of the expected \$1.5 million. ISU has committed that they will support the Lab schools financially. Those meetings also included discussions about

athletic chargebacks from ISU for U-High to use their facilities. For example, \$6,600 has been charged for the pool so far this year. For some sports, there are options that do not involve paying a fee.

- On a side note, but athletic related, U-High will be adding girls flag football next year.
- The Assistant Principal and Social Science jobs will be open. An Engineering teacher has been hired.
- Activity passes for 2026-2027 are not available yet.
