Treasurer Shannon Moreland	 Discuss Use of Boosters Name and Tax ID for grants. This is no longer an immediate need for decision. However, it may come up again with other clubs/sports wanting to use the school's tax id for grants. There are some hesitations around this as we need to keep Booster's total income below a threshold for tax purposes. There is a department at ISU that works with grants which is who band is working with now as they work on securing a grant. This ISU department is separate from the ISU Foundation. Resource	Funding Requests
Review Chris Grieshaber Matthias	 Dance submitted a request for uniforms. Last time they received funding was 2022-2023. They meet the criteria. They are asking for \$500 for uniforms. The size of the team grew causing them to need more. There is also a need to have IHSA approved poms.
	Angela Null motioned to approve the request. Matthias Pope seconded the motion and it unanimously passed.
	• Theater submitted a funding request for an updated device used for the soundboard. The total cost of the device is \$998.99. Mr. Webb attended the meeting to answer questions about th request. This technology will be used for all events in Stroud Auditorium so it will impact all students, not just those in theater. The reason an upgrade is being requested now is that a new software update was issued and this device is too old for the update to be installed on it. In addition, the tech crew needs access to more memory on the device to support production of the new shoes. Theater offered to contribute \$500 and requesting \$500. In addition, U-High tech budget is contributing \$300 to ensure the new device has the upgrade to 1 Terabyte and Apple Care warranty.
	Collette Fung motioned to give \$1,000 and cover the full amount of the device since it is used by the entire student population. Angela Null seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
	• Additional note that the website still says grants can be given every 3 years vs. the updated every 2 years. Chris will work on ensuring this update is made to the website. As for other

	•	changes to the website, Andrea, Steve, and Chris can sit down and discuss the things that need to be changed. Another reminder for groups receiving grants is that an stipulation for receiving grants is to have people from the groups volunteer for Boosters events.
