Officer Reports

President <i>Tim King</i>	• The Diversity Committee meeting was held this week and discussed ways to bring more awareness to 8th graders about applying to U-High and dispel misconceptions about what it takes to apply. • There is also a university-wide marketing initiative to increase awareness about applying. • Transportation is a major barrier for why students don't apply and aren't able to attend U-High. While no great solution has been found, the issue is understood and is being discussed.

Resource Review <i>Chris Grieshaber</i> <i>Matthias</i>	Funding Requests • (Christine Kyoto) Softball Request for uniforms • The U-High softball team will be adding a freshman team this year in addition to the JV and Varsity teams. The softball program needs extra funds to purchase uniforms and equipment to make it through the season. • Each of the 15 new freshmen will need a uniform jersey purchased for them to play. All of the teams need new practice and games balls each year. All players will need helmets and catching gear for catchers, as well as misc. equipment that needs replaced with age. • Coach Tolliver is requesting the max of \$500 to go towards the costs of operating 3 teams on the given budget. For example-The required game ball according to IHSA is a 9011 WTA9011BSST softball which will cost each team approx. \$119.95 plus shipping (\$359.85) for a dozen balls to just have enough game balls for the teams to play. More detailed costs for all the additional equipment the softball program will need to purchase can be provided if requested.

	• The team will be fundraising ongoing through the end of the season. They already work concessions at an Illinois State University football game to earn \$652.76 from this event. • Funds have not been given to softball in the past year. • Eric Thome motioned to approve \$500 for softball team. Erin Easter seconded the motion. The motion passed.
